

## Hosts: Responsibilities as a Six8 Host

### *Provide a Safe Performance Space*

Your number one responsibility as a host is to provide a safe, suitable, and welcoming space for the artist to perform. This means that there needs to be enough space for the artist/s that is free from any potential hazards. It also means that the artists don't receive abuse, any type of harassment, or bear witness to illegal behaviour.

### *Adhere to Regulations*

It's important you understand and abide by all local regulations, particularly with regard to sound and noise levels, and performance spaces. As the organiser of the event it is your responsibility to ensure that it's all legal, proactively manage the event, and resolve any problems with local authorities.

### *Protect Your Possessions*

Sometimes accidents happen, and things can get damaged. It is your responsibility to ensure that high value items are not put in harms way during an event. Any insurance is left completely to you discretion, but is recommended by Six8

### *Respect Each Other*

At the end of the day this is what it boils down to. Welcome the artist and treat them with respect. If they feel unsafe or placed in a poor work environment – they can choose to leave the event with the support of Six8. Likewise, if an artist is not behaving in a professional manner, it is your responsibility to rectify the situation and report any incidents to the relevant authorities.

### *Understand the Terms and Conditions*

This guide is designed to remind you of some important points you are responsible for when hosting an event but in no way supersedes or is as extensive as the obligations stated in the *Terms*. Make sure you understand your rights and responsibilities!
